



Alpine Releases intelliVIEW 16.02






Edit Opening and Move Opening Tools in iDesign - This tool improvement makes changing truss openings like attics and openings for FAU even easier.






Automatic Snow Drift loading in iDesign - The designer can now view and adjust system generated snow drift loads, simplifying the snow loading process.
