



Use Font, Point Tracking, & Element Tracking in CAD



IntelliVIEW enhanced the user options in CAD Utilities, adding Point Tracking and Element Tracking, under Use Font. These new options give you the ability to use a couple of popular AutoCAD tools in iModel. This enhancement was added in version 17.02.

To use these options, you will click on the CAD Utils icon on the Utilities toolbar. Once you have opened the CAD Utils toolbar, you will click on the Options icon, which will open the dialog box.









The "Use Font" box gives a more modern text option when checked, versus the traditional text when unchecked, as shown.



The "Use Point Tracking" tool uses a small cursor box that snaps to corners and intersections as you move your mouse around the screen. This makes it easier to determine which point you will be snapping the reference point.



The "Use Element Tracking" tool highlights the elements or objects closest to your cursor as you move your mouse around the screen.
